Your new manager will liaise with you and your parents. They will also notify you directly regarding any team matters such as training venues and times, match day venues and times.

Please ensure you give your manager your correct contact details.

For any information or problems your manager will be your first point of contact.

Like any youth organisation there are fees involved and we pride ourselves in making ours one of the cheapest in Dorset. If you are a player who both trains and plays once a week your fees for the season 2018/2019 are set at £110.00. If you train only then your fees will be £55.00

Q. what do you get for your money.

A. Your fees cover the following.

- All training pitch hires and matches day pitch hire.
- Basic equipment i.e., footballs, cones, bibs, first aid kit, speed ladder.
- Club insurance (copy available), League entry fees, and county cup entry fees.

Your manager and assistant will have undertaken the basic level 1 FA Coaching qualification and undergone an FA CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) check. They will have also attended an FA emergency aid workshop and safeguarding children workshop.

Q. what does it not cover

A. football kits and training kits

(N.B. The club will provide a new team with its first kit)

Q. who will collect the fees.

A. Two invoices will be sent. First invoice for £75 will be payable in September and the second for £35 in January. For trainers this will be in two halves also.

Payment details will be on the invoice.
